



PHASE 3 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Can teams travel to other destinations to play games?

A: There are no restrictions on travel, except that no team or player from a Stage 2 Public Health Region may travel to play in a Stage 3 Public Health Region.

Q: Are the limits on the number of participants applicable for each diamond, or for each facility?

A: The number of participants permitted at the outdoor facility may not exceed 100 people.

Q: What are the restrictions for league play, based on the 50 person limit outlined by the Ministry?

A: Leagues may compete as long as the league contains no more than 50 players and does not permit its teams to play against teams outside of the league, OR, if the league is larger than 50 players, the league must divide its teams into groups of 50 or fewer players and does not permit teams in different groups to play against one another, or against teams outside of the league.

Q: If a recreation facility has both indoor and outdoor space being used, is the maximum number of people allowed to increase to incorporate the 50 person indoor limit and the 100 person outdoor limit?

A: Indoor events and gatherings cannot be combined with an outdoor event or gathering to increase the applicable gathering size.

Q: Are spectators allowed?

A: Spectators at all sporting events will be subject to gathering limits and physical distancing measures. The total number of spectators permitted to be at a facility at any one time must be limited to the number that can maintain a physical distance of at least two metres from other people in the facility, and cannot exceed 50 spectators indoors or 100 spectators outdoors.

Q: What are the restrictions for Tournaments?

A: Tournaments are subject to the same travelling restrictions and maximum gathering numbers as outlined above.
